Number of riders under 18: 43

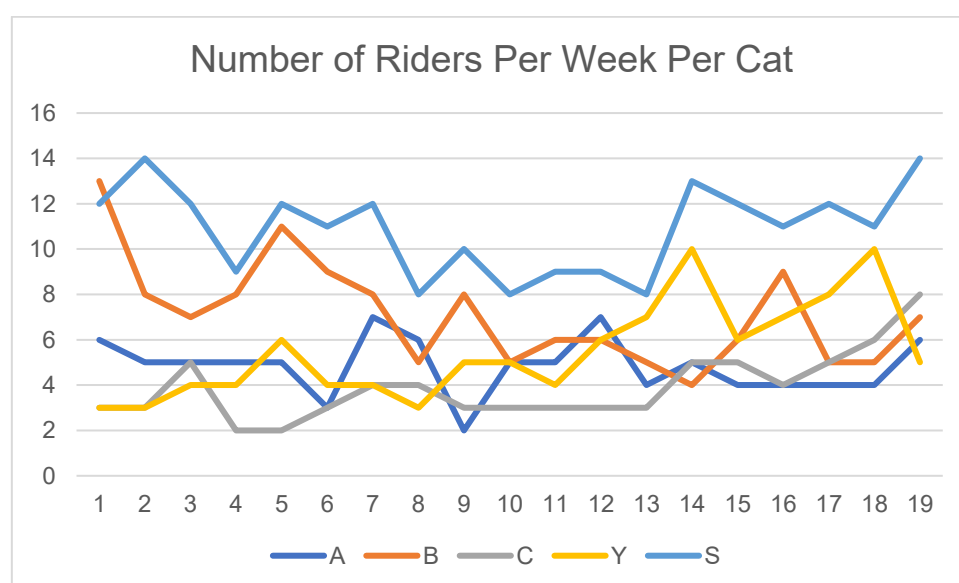
Number of riders over 18: 50
